We are looking for a PVK Manager (Pashu Vikas Kendra) for Pipariya location in Narmadapuram District MP, we are working around 200 villages under the Shwetdhara program in the five blocks of the Narmadapuram District, Under the Shwetdhara program we are providing the various health management services to the cattle rears of these blocks, We are providing the AI, repeat breeder, infertility, deworming, vaccination and other health management services through AI technicians in these blocks. A FPO has been established around the dairy sector, and our main objective to make FPC viable through livestock and agriculture input sell and services through village level cadres.

Role description |

- PVK Manager will be the point of person to all activities in the cluster and will be responsible for the mobilization of women under Shwetdhara group in the village
- He/She will be responsible for the Selection and nurturing of the Gramsakhhi and AI cadres in the villages and would be responsible for training and capacity building to the SDG and Gram-sakhhi group for follow the best management practices by farmers in cattle rearing and business expansion by gram-sakhhis to sell the input and provide extension services to farmers,
- He/She will map the farmers' needs for input supply for cattle farming in order to increase the productivity of cattle, he or she would undertake a comparative analysis of the various inputs used by local farmers.
- Need to oversee the management of various stakeholders for the cluster's deepening of service, including village local bodies, village and block level officials, and various vendors supplying inputs to villages and need to create various individual and collective enterprises in their cluster.

- He/she offers beneficiaries training on enterprise growth, including business plans, financial links, and local market links for the inputs and services.
- He/she will oversee regularly writing reports, documentation, and preparing case studies and in charge of resolving disputes between groups at the village level.
